

Disappearing Grids & Filters



Show All

Sometimes, eCoordinator grids & filters will stick from one grid to another. When you are starting a new search, it always makes sense to start with the "Clear Filters" button in the volunteer and opportunities grids and the "Show All" button in the logbook grids.

The filters may also disappear when you sort a column in the grid or filter through the column header. After your sort, you can reselect the filter.
