Changes to the Apply-To Opportunity

Angler Ed Activities

There are some things that Master Naturalists need to be aware of when reporting and approving Angler Ed Hours...

If your volunteer is an instructor of the Angler Ed opportunity - and has ordered supplies through TPWD (with Karen Marks) - they need to record those hours to TPWD. Karen uses those entries to get reimbursed for the supplies.

If you have an opportunity called Angler Ed, we will modify the name a bit to note that it is a TMN opportunity.

Also note that our opportunities have "**TMN**-XX Hours" after the opportunity name in their drop-down box.

URL Links to the eRecruiter login page

Be sure that links from your webpages or emails links to the '1450' site, not the '1353' site. The '1353' site is used by TPWD and does not have the TMN Hours on the summary page.

The URL will look like this:

https://tpwd.samaritan.com/recruiter/index.php? class=VolunteerNavigation&recruiterID=1353&act=CONTROL:LOGIN_LINK

The good link will have 'recruiterID=1450' in the URL. The safest way to get the good link is to use the shortcut: TXMN.org/Hours.

Field in Focus - Current Chapter Syntax



The proper syntax for the Current Chapter field should be XXX Master Naturalists (plural). That way the Background Check card that is emailed reads properly. The other Chapter fields are not currently used elsewhere.
