

Fields in Focus: Milestone Awards

We honor and recognize milestone winners at the annual meeting. Be sure to update your volunteer milestones and initial certifications so that we can accurately acknowledge those volunteers. Generally, the 'Awarded' field is used to note that they have received their pin while the 'Earned Date' field is the date that they actually passed the award hours.




Update your Officer List

Be sure to keep your officer list current. For officers cycling out or over to a different position, note their old position in the history field.

Be sure to get your new officers trained in the VMS system. You can sign up for Admin 101, Admin 201, Admin Refresher and Read Only training https://example.com/here/.

The VMS fields are 1) VMS Admin for the general VMS user, 2) VMS LBE for the VMS admin with 45 day edit capability (usually 1 per chapter) and 3) VMS Read Only access.



Naming Filters, Grids & Templates

Be sure to include your chapter name/acronym to filter grids, filters and templates that you create so that they will sort properly, and we will have some idea who created them for troubleshooting purposes. All TMN Standard objects should not be

editable, but we have found that there have been some access role changes that allowed that to happen.

The Help Desk

Remind your volunteers that the chapter VMS Admin should be their first contact for questions. If they need to get further assistance, do NOT use the built-in VMS help system as it goes to the TPWD VMS group and then has to be forwarded to the Texas Master Naturalist VMS Team. This slows the response considerably. Instead, instruct them to use the TMN VMS Help Desk at <a href="https://example.com/transform/remains-rema

Warning! - Disapproving LBE entries bug

We have found that if you disapprove logbook entries without having at least one logbook entry selected - it will disapprove them all. Be careful out there!

Using the EDGE Browser with VMS

We have found a potential problem using the MS Edge Browser with VMS. There is a setting in Edge called "save and fill basic information". In some instances, it will fill in <u>your</u> personal information when working with volunteer profiles and logbook entries. If you want to continue to use this feature in Edge, we suggest you use Chrome as your browser when you are using VMS.
