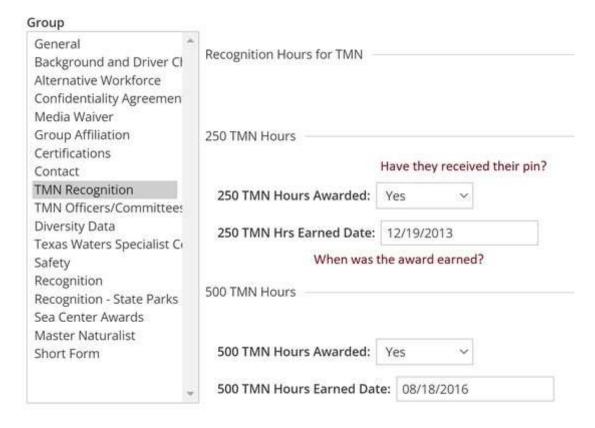

Field in Focus: Milestone Dates

Be sure to keep your milestone data current

There are 2 fields for recording milestones - the awarded status and the award date. The awarded status (Yes/No) can be used to record whether the volunteer has received their pin (some chapters only pass out pins at the end of the year). The date is used to indicate when they met the requirements for the milestone. This is the date that we use when recognizing volunteers at the annual meeting.

Interim Training Class Policy

2022 is another 'covid year' when it comes to the operating procedures for our training classes

In a nutshell, they mirror the interim policy from 2021 but have a couple additions addressing the Hybrid Annual Meeting held in 2021 and our new #TMNTuesday advanced training webinars offered by the TMN state program office.

Training for New Officers

We offer VMS training for Admins - 101 and Advanced. Also available is a reporting class and a read-only class. If your chapter has special needs let us know and we could put something together for you. We also offer Webex training for other leaders in your chapter.

Find scheduled training at <u>txmn.org/help</u> and look for the Administrative Training Schedule. If you need a class that's not pre-scheduled put in a help desk request and we can set something up for you.

You must complete a VMS training session before you get your login ID.

PDFs for your Chapter Archives and Backup

If you would like to save your chapter information for archival purposes you can do it by creating PDF reports of your volunteer and opportunity lists. Start with the grid that you want to save - probably the Chapter Leadership or any of the volunteer rosters. You might also want to do a logbook report of the folks that certified or recertified that year. After you've opened the grid that you want, go to the

Report/Volunteer Data Grid and then select the the columns that you want to exclude and print to PDF. Some tweaking might be necessary to get it all on a page.

You can also export to Excel format for other reporting and analysis.

2021 Data Review

We've finished the 2021 Data Review. It consisted of the same statistics that we've gathered for the past few years, but the time frame will change a bit. The logbook statistics and analysis are for 2020. We will be pulling the 2021 logbook data in February/March in time to run the annual report and we'll present the data at the March All-Admin meeting.

The only opportunity logbook analysis that we are doing is a closer look at the "Other" category and board type work that we've done for other agencies.
