# Fields in Focus: Decimals in Hours Recorded

Often volunteers might get confused when putting in partial hours in the hours field of the survey. We recommend that they round up to the nearest quarter hour and only use .25, .50 or .75.


# **Update your Officer List**

We will be updating the officer list to match the CMOP. We will make the changes for your chapter.

Be sure to keep your officer list current. For officers cycling out or over to a different position, note their old position in the history field.

Be sure to get your new officers trained in the VMS system. You can sign up for Admin 101, Admin 201, Admin Refresher and Read Only training <a href="https://example.com/here/">here</a>.

The VMS fields are 1) VMS Admin for the general VMS user, 2) VMS LBE for the VMS admin with 45 day edit capability (usually 1 per chapter) and 3) VMS Read Only access.

Can you believe 2022 has come to an end? It's time to make sure that all of your volunteers have their 2022 hours in as soon as possible.

You also might want to take some archival reports of your opportunities and volunteers for your chapter historical records. Find a grid that has the information that you want to keep track of and go to Reports/Data Grid - to export to excel or a pdf.
